During Lockdown we have all been keeping busy doing lots of different activities;

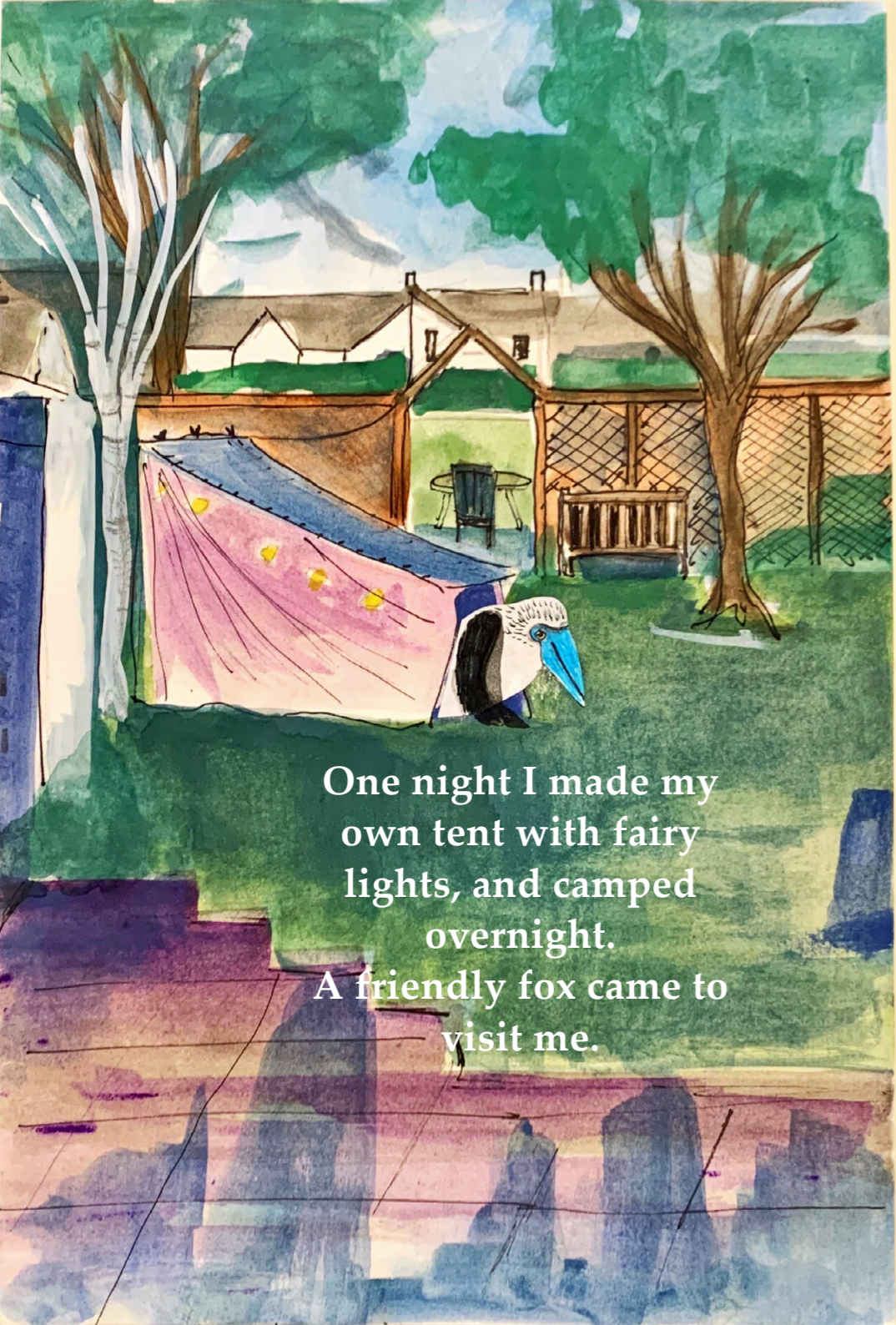


I have had a lot of fun practising tight rope walking in my garden.

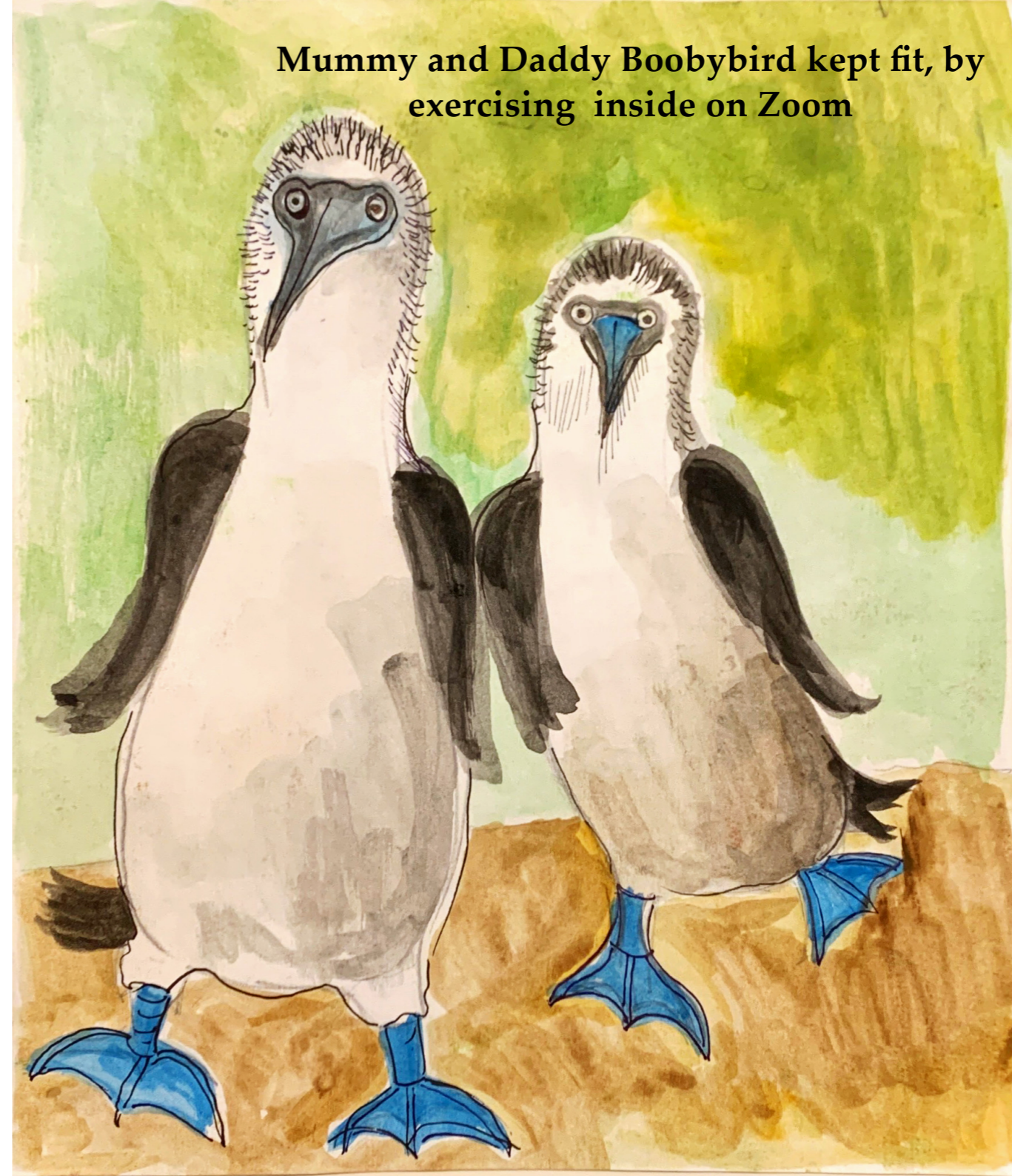
It wasn't easy!

exercising inside on Zoom

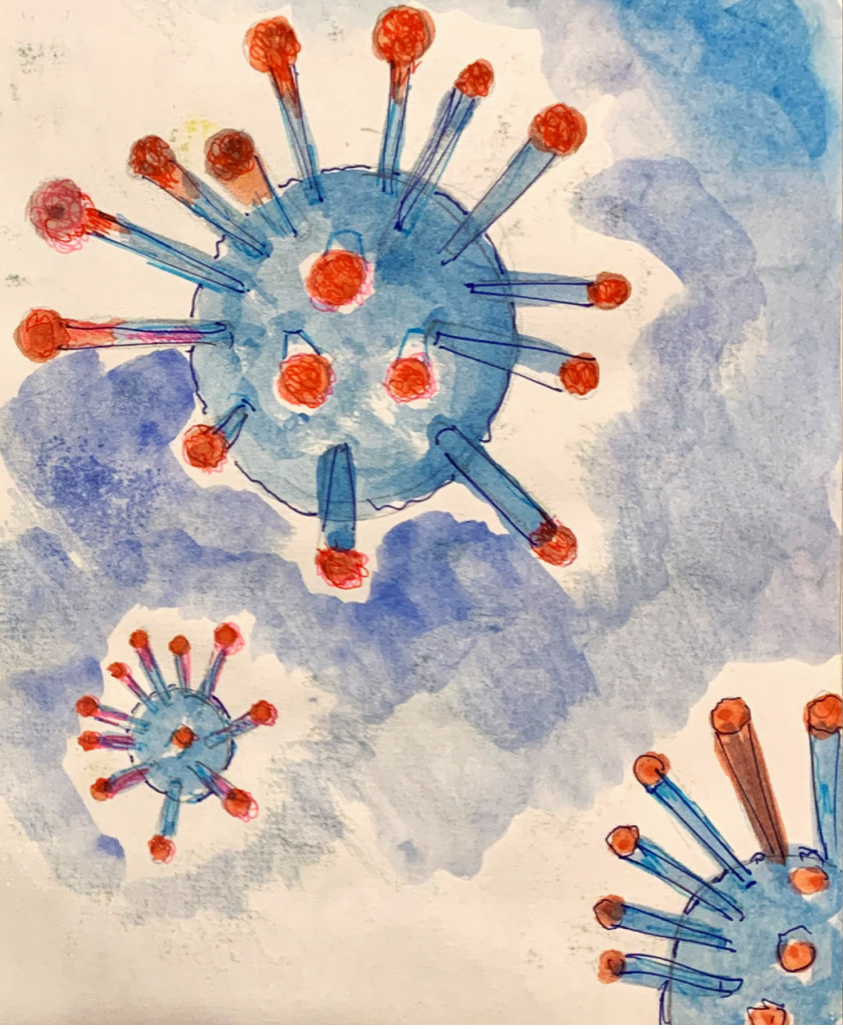


**Daddy Boobybird started growing vegetables.

**Coronavirus is a disease that has spread all over the world, and made many people very ill.**



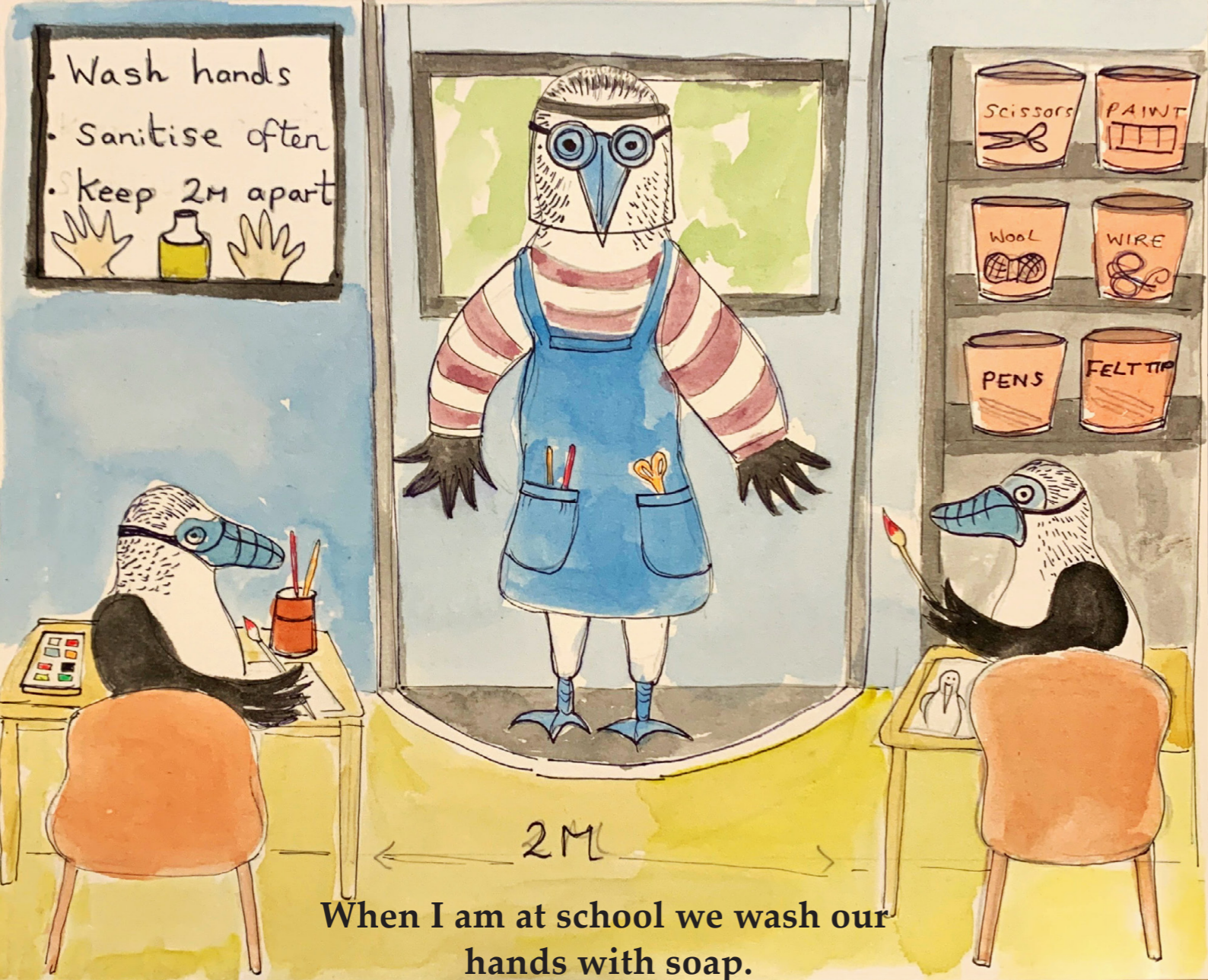
Every day our family watches the news to find out what is happening around the world.
